BY-LAW 775-2022

To authorize the alteration of Chisholm Avenue, between Lumsden Avenue and Hamstead Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Chisholm Avenue, between Lumsden Avenue and Hamstead Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

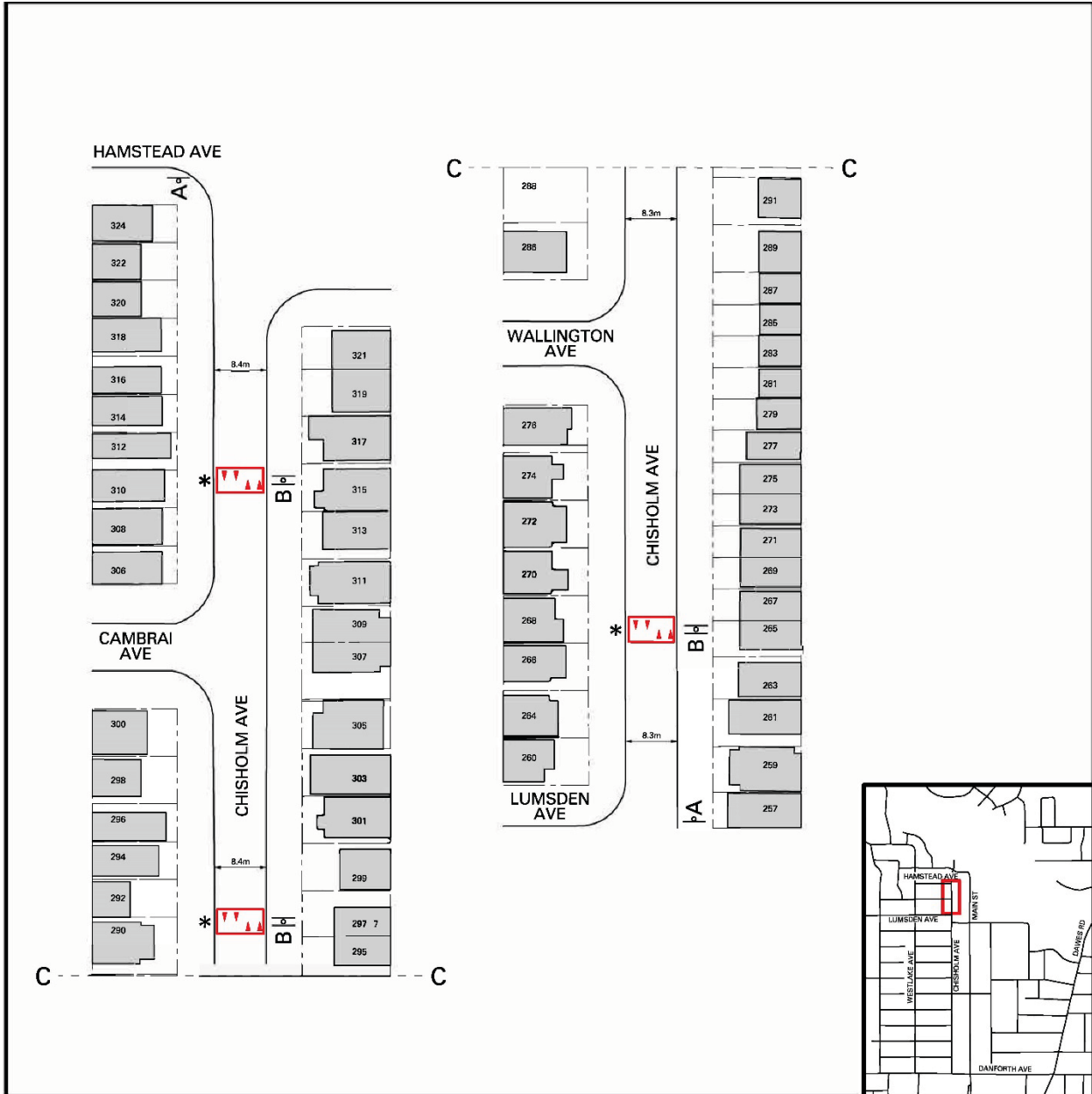
