### BY-LAW 900-2022

#### **To permanently close the untraveled public lane behind 127 King Street.**

Whereas it is recommended that part of the lane legally described as Part of Lane on Registered Plan 182, Township of York Abutting Lots 155-181; Toronto (York), City of Toronto and designated as Part 2 on Reference Plan 66R-32634, be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said lane was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 162, and the Etobicoke York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on June 27, 2022;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public lane described below is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of Lane on Registered Plan 182, Township of York Abutting Lots 155-181;  
Toronto (York), City of Toronto (York), City of Toronto, designated as Part 2 on  
Reference Plan 66R-32634.
