BY-LAW 948-2022

To amend By-law 548-2022, Creative Colocation Facilities subclass for the Commercial, Commercial Residual and the Industrial property tax classes.

Whereas at its meeting of June 16, 2022, City Council enacted 548-2022, which by-law set out the properties to be included in the Creative Colocation Facilities subclass for the Commercial, Commercial Residual and the Industrial property tax classes for 2022; and

Whereas 224 Augusta Avenue ceases to qualify for the Creative Colocation Facilities subclass;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 548-2022 is amended by deleting the following from Section 1(3):
 - (oo) 1,012 sq. ft. at 224 Augusta Avenue, as further described as Assessment Roll Number 1904-06-5-650-02100-0000-04;
2. This By-law is deemed to have come into force on July 12, 2022.
