CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 955-2022

To amend By-law 576-2022, being a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, and By-law 578-2022, being a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 632, Property, Vacant or Hazardous.

Whereas City of Toronto Council enacted By-laws 576-2022 and 578-2022; and

Whereas City of Toronto Council specified that By-laws 576-2022 and 578-2022 shall come into force on March 1, 2023; and

Whereas Section 169-5.2 of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, permits the City Solicitor to submit bills directly to Council to make technical and other amendments;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1.** City of Toronto By-law 576-2022 is amended by adding the following as a new Section:

This by-law shall come into force on March 1, 2023.
- 2.** City of Toronto By-law 578-2022 is amended by adding the following as a new Section:

This by-law shall come into force on March 1, 2023.
- 3.** This by-law shall come into force on June 16, 2022.
