CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 997-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Cherry Street and Commissioners Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days) |
|-----------------------------|--------------------------|--|---|
| Cherry Street | Both | Commissioners Street (west intersection) and Polson Street | Anytime |
| Commissioners Street | Both | Cherry Street (east intersection) and the west end of Commissioners Street | Anytime |

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway) | (In Column 2 Direction) | (In Column 3 Turns Prohibited) | (In Column 4 Times and/or Days) |
|---|-------------------------------|---|--|
| Cherry Street and Commissioners Street (east intersection) | Southbound | Right | When traffic control signal shows red |
| Cherry Street (west intersection) and Commissioners Street | Northbound | Right | When traffic control signal shows red |

C. By inserting in Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Speed Limit (km/h)) |
|-----------------------------|---|--|
| Cherry Street | Polson Street and Commissioners Street (west intersection) | 40 |
| Commissioners Street | Cherry Street (east intersection) and the west end of Commissioners Street | 40 |

2. Section 1 of this By-law shall take effect on the date that Section 1 of By-law 996-2022 is in effect.
