BY-LAW 1024-2022

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Front Street East, Mill Street and Parliament Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule VII (Passenger Loading Zones) in § 950-1305, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Front Street East	South	Between Trinity Street and a point 70 metres west of Cherry Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022

- B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Front Street East	North	Trinity Street and Cherry Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Mill Street	North	A point 61 metres east of Trinity Street and a point 122 metres east of Trinity	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Mill Street	South	A point 101 metres east of Parliament Street and Trinity Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022

City of Toronto By-law 1024-2022

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Mill Street	South	Parliament Street and a point 90 metres east	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Parliament Street	Both	King Street East and Lake Shore Boulevard East	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022

C. By inserting a new Subsection (8) in § 950-1202A as follows:

"(8) During the time frame indicated in the entry in Subsection 1A to 1B, inclusive, of By-law 1024-2022, the provisions of Subsections 1A to 1B of By-law 1024-2022 shall apply notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other by-law or chapter of the Municipal Code. For further clarity, where any regulation contained in Subsection 1A to 1B, inclusive, of By-law 1024-2022 conflicts with any other regulation in any Schedule of the Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, the regulation as found in By-law 1024-2022 shall prevail during the time frame outlined in the regulation as found in By-law 1024-2022."
