## BY-LAW 1028-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Cherry Street and Commissioners Street.

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Cherry Street	A point 23 metres south of Polson Street and a point 104 metres further south	Westerly Northbound and Southbound	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Commissioners Street	Cherry Street (west intersection) and a point 30 metres east of Cherry Street (east intersection)	Northerly Westbound	Anytime
Commissioners Street	Cherry Street (west intersection) and a point 30 metres east of Cherry Street (east intersection)	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime

2. Section 1 of this By-law shall take effect on the date that Section 1 of By-law 996-2022, is in effect.
