To amend By-law 1174-2010, as amended by By-law 942-2021, being a by-law to amend former City of Toronto Zoning By-law 438-86 to remove the holding symbol (H) with respect to the lands known municipally as 324 Cherry Street and 429 Lake Shore Boulevard East.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 and Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to impose the holding symbol (H) and to remove the holding symbol (H) when Council is satisfied that the conditions relating to the holding symbol have been satisfied; and

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:


1. Map A of By-law 942-2021 is amended by removing the holding symbol (H) from the lands shown shaded on the attached Schedule 1.
