### **BY-LAW 33-2023**

**To authorize the alteration of Coleridge Avenue, between Barker Avenue and Lumsden Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Coleridge Avenue, between Barker Avenue and Lumsden Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Coleridge Avenue, between Barker Avenue and Lumsden Avenue, by the installation of two speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-4009 dated April 2022 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
