## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 35-2023**

**To authorize the alteration of Brandon Avenue, between Lansdowne Avenue and Lightbourn Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Brandon Avenue, between Lansdowne Avenue and Lightbourn Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Brandon Avenue, between Lansdowne Avenue and Lightbourn Avenue, by the installation of five speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-3948 dated September 2021 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
