BY-LAW 42-2023

To authorize the alteration of Virginia Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Woodmount Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Virginia Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Woodmount Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Virginia Avenue, between Woodbine Avenue and Woodmount Avenue, by the installation of two speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-4011 dated April 2022 attached to this By-law, is authorized.

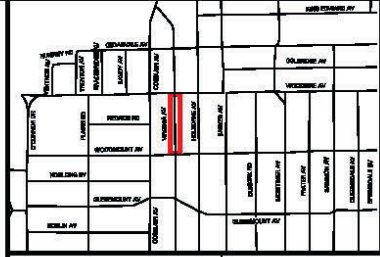
