## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 44-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Amsterdam Avenue and Glenburn Avenue.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

C. By inserting in XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
