BY-LAW 52-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Oak Park Avenue and Wallington Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)
Oak Park Avenue	The south side of Cosburn Avenue and the north side of Lumsden Avenue

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)
Oak Park Avenue	The south side of Cosburn Avenue and the north side of Wallington Avenue
Oak Park Avenue	The south side of Wallington Avenue and the north side of Lumsden Avenue

- C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Oak Park Avenue	Oak Park Avenue and Wallington Avenue
