BY-LAW 56-2023

To confirm the proceedings of Toronto and East York Community Council at Meeting 1 held on November 30, 2022 as they relate to decisions made under delegated authority.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The action of the Toronto and East York Community Council on November 30, 2022, taken under the delegated authority in Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, in respect of Items TE1.8, TE1.9, TE1.10, TE1.15, TE1.16, TE1.19, TE1.20, TE1.21, TE1.22, TE1.23, TE1.24, TE1.25, TE1.26, TE1.27, TE1.31, TE1.33, TE1.34, TE1.35, TE1.36, TE1.37, TE1.38, TE1.39, TE1.40, TE1.41, TE1.42, TE1.43, TE1.44, TE1.45, TE1.46 and TE1.47 of the Toronto and East York Community Council, up to and including the voting on this Confirmatory By-law at the conclusion of its meeting at 12:29 p.m. this day, and in respect of each motion, resolution and other action, passed and taken under delegated authority including the enactment of any previous Confirmatory By-laws in respect of the meeting, is adopted, ratified and confirmed.
2. The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, the City Clerk and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the City's seal to the documents.
3. This By-law, to the extent to which it provides authority for or constitutes the exercise by the Community Council of its powers to proceed with, or to provide any money for, any undertaking, work, project, scheme, act, matter or thing which requires an approval in addition to the approval of the Community Council, shall not take effect until the additional approval has been obtained.
4. For the purposes of the exercise of the authority of the head of council to veto a by-law in accordance with section 226.9 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, this Confirmatory By-law shall be deemed to be separate Confirmatory By-laws for each item listed on the agenda.
