## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 68-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, to enable alignment with changes arising from Bill 3 (Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022).**

Whereas Bill 3, Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022 ("Bill 3"), amended the City of Toronto Act, 2006 to provide specific powers and duties to the Mayor formerly provided to City Council; and

Whereas Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, requires updates to enable alignment with the changes arising from Bill 3 and Mayoral decisions made under Bill 3;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection to § 169-2.4:

The City Clerk may process by-laws if the by-law is required as a result of the coming into force of Part VI.1 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 or a decision made by the Mayor under Part VI.1 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006.

2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection to § 169-5.2:

The City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council for enactment where an action is required as a result of the coming into force of Part VI.1 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 or a decision made by the Mayor under Part VI.1 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006.
