BY-LAW 73-2023

To make a technical amendment to By-law 1097-2021 with respect to the east-west part of the public highway known as Guest Avenue.

Whereas City Council has delegated to the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, by Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the authority to submit bills directly to Council to correct technical errors; and

Whereas there was an error in By-law 1097-2021 as the legal description has been amended;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Section 1 of By-law 1097-2021 is deleted and replaced with the following new Section 1:

Part of the public highway known as Guest Avenue, Toronto, and described as follows in hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 21013-0250 (LT)
Part of Lot 12, Registered Plan 666, City of Toronto,
Designated as Parts 1 and 17 on Plan 66R-32280
