CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 93-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Batavia Avenue, Beechwood Avenue, Eileen Avenue, French Avenue, Glenvalley Drive and Seneca Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Batavia Avenue	West	A point 71 metres north of St. Clair Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Seneca Avenue	North	A point 76.3 metres east of Avon Avenue and a point 7.1 metres further east	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Beechwood Avenue	East	A point 114.2 metres north of Outlook Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north,	Anytime from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Beechwood Avenue	West	A point 115.8 metres north of Outlook Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30th, inclusive and from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive

Eileen Avenue	North	A point 178 metres west of Scarlett Road and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
French Avenue	West	A point 43.6 metres south of Pritchard Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Glenvalley Drive	North	A point 107.1 metres west of Weston Road and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
