BY-LAW 289-2023

To amend Zoning By-law 569-2013, as amended by By-law 1151-2022(OLT), to remove the holding symbol (h) with respect to the lands known municipally in the year 2022 as 234-250 King Street East and 162 Princess Street.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 and Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to impose the holding symbol (h) and to remove the holding symbol (h) when Council is satisfied that the conditions relating to the holding symbol (h) have been satisfied; and

Whereas there are Official Plan policies in effect addressing the use of the holding symbol (h); and

Whereas the conditions relating to the holding symbol (h) have been satisfied in order to lift the holding symbol (h) in relation to the lands to which this by-law applies; and;

Whereas Council has provided notice of the intent to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The lands subject to this By-law are outlined by heavy black lines on Diagram 1 attached to this By-law.
2. Diagram 2 of By-law 1151-2022(OLT) is hereby is amended by removing the holding symbol (h) from the lands shown on the attached Diagram 2.

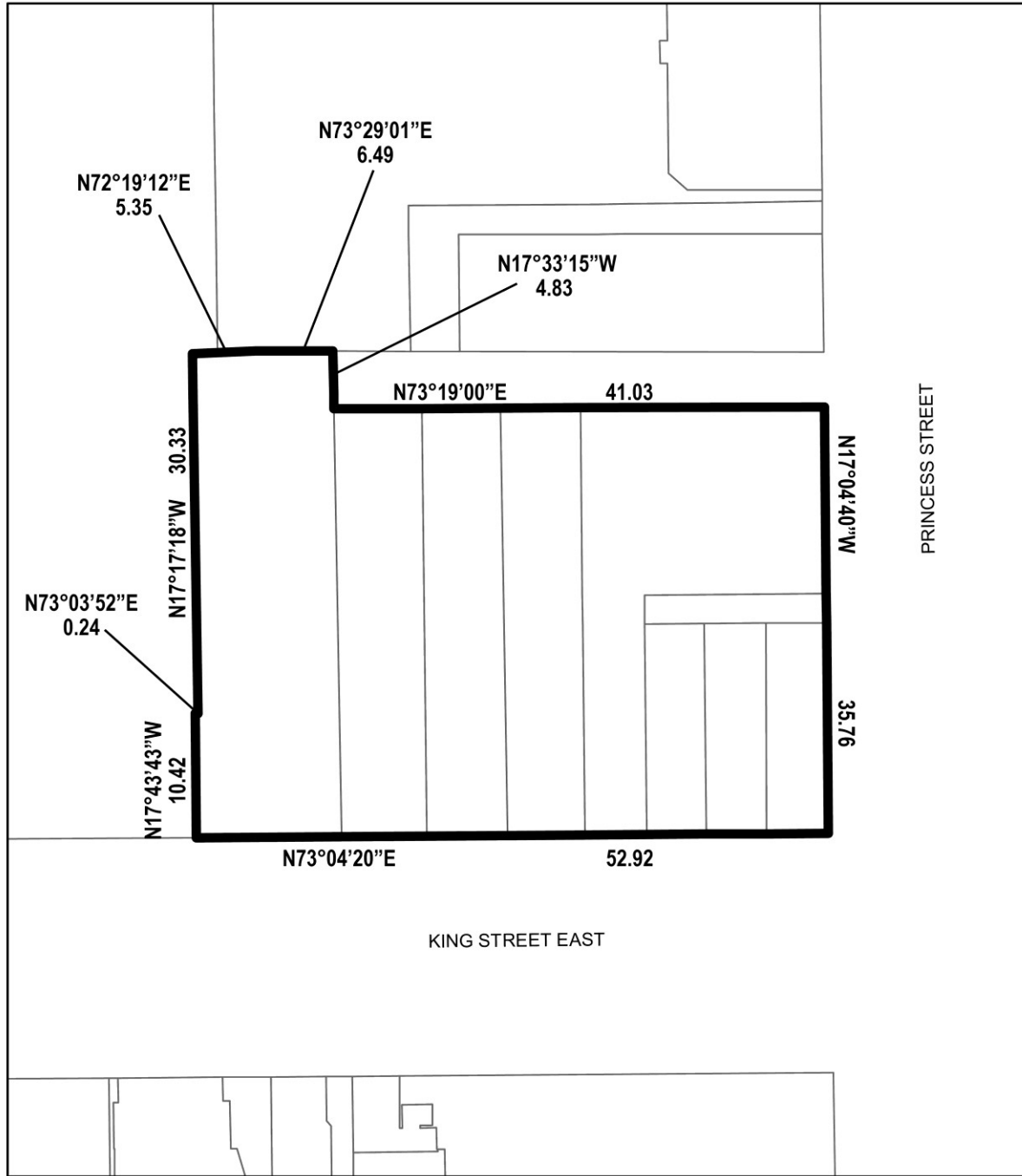
