CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 305-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 213, Real Property.

Whereas City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 213, Real Property requires technical amendments to reflect a governance change and to correct the inadvertent omission in subsection 213-2.2. of one of the positions to whom approval authority has been delegated by Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 213, Real Property, is amended as follows:
 - a. In subsection 213-1.2., add the following:

STANDING COMMITTEE - A standing committee established under section 226.6 of City of Toronto Act, 2006.
 - b. In subsection 213-1.6., delete "General Government and Licensing Committee" and replace it with "appropriate standing committee".
2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 213, Real Property, is amended by deleting subsection 213-2.2. and replacing it with the following:

§ 213-2.2. Delegation of Approval Authority.

Approval authority for the real estate matters set out in Appendix A to this chapter is delegated to the City Manager; Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services; Executive Director, Corporate Real Estate Management; Director, Real Estate Services; and Manager, Real Estate Services, respectively, as indicated in Appendix A, subject to compliance with the General Conditions set out in Appendix B to this chapter.
