Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Castle Frank Road, between Drumsnab Road and Dale Avenue, and waived the polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

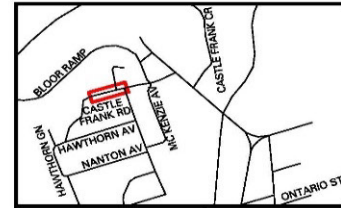
