BY-LAW 363-2023

To authorize the naming of a public lane south of Queen Street East, extending between Morse Street and Carlaw Avenue as Kit Hood Lane.

Whereas pursuant to Section 27-18.4E(4) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

and shown as PART 1 on Sketch No. PS-2022-004 attached to this By-law is named Kit Hood Lane.


