## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 462-2023

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Parliament Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Parliament Street	East	Queen Street East and Shuter Street	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat.	1 hour
Parliament Street	West	Shuter Street and Queen Street East	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat.	1 hour
