BY-LAW 574-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Harbord Street and Palmerston Boulevard.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Palmerston Boulevard	East	College Street and Bloor Street West	16th day to the last day of each month, from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Palmerston Boulevard	West	College Street and Bloor Street West	Anytime, from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive
Palmerston Boulevard	West	College Street and Bloor Street West	First day to the 15th day of each month, from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive

B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Harbord Street and Palmerston Boulevard	Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
