BY-LAW 579-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Palmerston Boulevard.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Time and/or Days) | (In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted) |
|-----------------------------|--------------------------|-------------------------------------|--------------------------------------|---|
| Palmerston Boulevard | West | College Street and Ulster Street | Anytime | 2 hours |
