BY-LAW 593-2023

To repeal By-law 455-2023, which provides for the entering into of a heritage easement agreement for the conservation of the property known municipally as 72-78 Berkeley Street

Whereas two identical by-laws, By-law 442-2023 and By-law 455-2023, both to enter into a heritage easement agreement for the conservation of the property known municipally as 72-78 Berkeley Street, were inadvertently placed on the Bills List, adopted by City Council at its meeting on May 10, 11 and 12, 2023 and enacted and passed on May 15, 2023; and

Whereas no action has been taken as authorized under By-law 455-2023 to enter into a heritage easement agreement; and

Whereas this by-law repeals By-law 455-2023; and

Whereas By-law 442-2023 remains in full force and effect;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 455-2023, being a by-law to "To provide for the entering into a heritage easement agreement for the conservation of the property known municipally as 72-78 Berkeley Street" is repealed.
