## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 594-2023**

#### **To appoint an interim Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer under the City of Toronto Act, 2006.**

Whereas the position of Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer of the City will become vacant and it is therefore necessary to appoint an Interim Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for the City of Toronto, which position is also the interim statutory treasurer under the City of Toronto Act, 2006;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Stephen Conforti is appointed Interim Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer, and interim statutory treasurer for the City of Toronto for the purposes of s. 138 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 (the "Act"), with all of the powers conferred and duties imposed by the Act and by Chapter 169 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
2. This by-law shall come into effect on the latter of July 5, 2023 and such dates as Stephen Conforti has entered into an employment contract with the City for the position of Interim Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer and shall continue in effect until such time as a Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for the City of Toronto has been appointed.
