CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 626-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Elmhurst Avenue and Glendora Avenue.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XLIV (Electric Vehicle Charging Station Parking) in § 950-1343, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between) | (In Column 4 Hours (daily as indicated below)) | (In Column 5 Maximum Period Parking) |
|-----------------------|--------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------|------------------------------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| Elmhurst Avenue | South | A point 66.3 metres east of Beecroft Road and a point 12 metres further east | Anytime | 3 hours |
| Glendora Avenue | North | A point 22.1 metres east of Yonge Street and a point 12 metres further east | Anytime | 3 hours |
| Glendora Avenue | North | A point 24.1 metres west of Bates Avenue and a point 12 metres further west | Anytime | 3 hours |
