**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 636-2023**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Arundel Avenue, Eleanor Avenue, Lesmount Avenue and Osborne Avenue.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Eleanor Avenue	South	A point 42 metres west of Oakwood Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Lesmount Avenue	East	A point 9 metres south of O'Connor Drive and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Arundel Avenue	East	A point 105 metres south of Browning Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime, from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive, and Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Arundel Avenue	West	A point 107 metres south of Browning Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime, from the 16th to the last day of each month, from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Lesmount Avenue	East	A point 20 metres south of O'Connor Drive and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Osborne Avenue	East	A point 85 metres north of Lyall Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
