BY-LAW 719-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
 Carlaw Avenue, Christie Street, Dundas Street West, Gerrard Street East, King Street
 West, Kingston Road, Ossington Avenue, Queen Street East and Roncesvalles Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XLIV (Electric Vehicle Charging Station Parking) in
 § 950-1343, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
