CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 720-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Bloor Street West, Gladstone Avenue, Ontario Street, Sackville Street, Sumach Street and Winchester Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------------|--|---|-----------------------------------|
| Gladstone Avenue | Cross Street and Dundas Street West | Easterly Northbound | Anytime |
| Gladstone Avenue | Peel Avenue and Argyle Avenue | Easterly Northbound | Anytime |
| Gladstone Avenue | Waterloo Avenue and Cross Street | Easterly Northbound adjacent to parking | Anytime |
| Sackville Street | Wellesley Street East and Gerrard Street East | Easterly Northbound | Anytime |
| Sumach Street | Wellesley Street East and Gerrard Street East | Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
| Winchester Street | Parliament Street and Rose Avenue | Northerly Westbound | Anytime |
| Winchester Street | Rose Avenue and Ontario Street | Northerly Westbound lane adjacent to parking | Anytime |

B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------------|---|--|-----------------------------------|
| Bloor Street West | Aberfoyle Crescent and Resurrection Road | Northerly Westbound and Southerly Eastbound | Anytime |
| Bloor Street West | A point 22.5 metres west of Runnymede Road and Aberfoyle Crescent | Northerly Westbound | Anytime |
| Bloor Street West | A point 41 metres west of Runnymede Road and Aberfoyle Crescent | Southerly Eastbound | Anytime |
| Ontario Street | Carleton Street and Aberdeen Avenue | Easterly northbound | Anytime |
