BY-LAW 722-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
 Bloor Street West, Colborne Lodge Drive, High Park Avenue and Parkside Drive.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in
 alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West and Colborne Lodge Drive	Eastbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in
 alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street West and High Park Avenue/Colborne Lodge Drive	Westbound	Left	Anytime (bicycles excepted)
Bloor Street West and High Park Avenue/Colborne Lodge Drive	Eastbound	Right	Anytime (bicycles excepted)
Parkside Drive and High Park Boulevard	Northbound	Left	Sunday (bicycles excepted)
Parkside Drive and High Park Boulevard	Southbound	Right	Sunday (bicycles excepted)

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(In Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(In Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Bloor Street West	High Park Avenue	Colborne Lodge Drive
Parkside Drive	High Park Boulevard, east of Parkside Drive	High Park Boulevard, west of Parkside Drive, anytime Sun.
