**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 724-2023**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting  
 Bloor Street East.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule V (Stands for Taxicabs) in § 950-1304, the following in  
 alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Location)	(From Column 4 Number of Taxicabs)	(From Column 5 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street East	South	West of Sherbourne Street	2	Anytime, except 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.

B. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in  
 alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street East	Both	Sherbourne Street and a point 50 metres west	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street East	North	Sherbourne Street and a point 50 metres west	Anytime
Bloor Street East	South	Sherbourne Street and a point 47 metres west	Anytime
Bloor Street East	South	A point 133 metres west of Sherbourne Street and Huntley Street	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule VII (Passenger Loading Zones) in § 950-1306, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Bloor Street East	South	A point 47 metres west of Sherbourne Street and a point 20 metres further west	Anytime
