BY-LAW 726-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Brant Street and King Street West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Pedestrian Crossovers) in § 950-1337, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Location)
King Street West	Immediately west of Brant Street
 - B. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In
Column 1
Intersection/Location)
King Street West and Brant Street
