## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 737-2023

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, to increase certain police fees.

Whereas it is necessary to update Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, to reflect new fees and charges for the Toronto Police Services as approved by Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, is amended by deleting the fees under Reference Numbers 10, 13, 18, 19 and 20 of Appendix B, Schedule 2 - Toronto Police Services, and replacing them with the following:
