AMENDMENT 685 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN

LANDS MUNICIPALLY KNOWN IN THE YEAR 2022 AS 264 KENILWORTH AVENUE AND 50 NORWAY AVENUE

The Official Plan of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- 1. Chapter 7, Site and Area Specific Policies, is amended by adding Site and Area Specific Policy 868 for lands known municipally in 2022 as 264 Kenilworth Avenue and 50 Norway Avenue, as follows:
 - 868. 264 Kenilworth Avenue and 50 Norway Avenue

Notwithstanding Policy 3.2.1.8 of the Official Plan, the social housing property located at 264 Kenilworth Avenue and 50 Norway Avenue may be severed into two conveyable parcels of land for conveyance to non-profit housing providers.

2. Chapter 7, Map 32, Site and Area Specific Policies, is amended to add the lands known municipally in 2022 as 264 Kenilworth Avenue and 50 Norway Avenue shown on the map below as Site and Area Specific Policy 868.
