BY-LAW 923-2023

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
Central Park Roadway/Private Access and Cordova Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Cordova Avenue and Central Park Roadway/Private Access	Southbound and northbound	Right turns and left turns	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(In Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(In Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Cordova Avenue	Central Park Roadway (westbound)	Private access opposite Central Park Roadway

C. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Pedestrian Crossovers) in § 950-1337, the
following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Location)
Cordova Avenue	Immediately northwest of Central Park Roadway

D. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In
Column 1
Intersection/Location)

Cordova Avenue and Central Park Roadway/Private Access
