BY-LAW 933-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 910, Parking Machines and Meters, respecting Lake Shore Boulevard West, The Queensway and Weston Road.

The Council of The City of Toronto enacts:

- Chapter 910, Parking Machines, is amended by adding the following in alphabetical order to Schedule II (Parking Machine Locations Designated as Electric Vehicle Charging Stations):

Lake Shore Boulevard West	West	A point 28.8 metres north of Superior Avenue and 6 metres further north	9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun.	\$1.00 for 1 hour	3 hours
The Queensway	South	A point 24.8 metres west of Inverleigh Drive and a point 12 metres further west	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat.	\$1.00 for 1 hour	3 hours
Weston Road	West	A point 177.3 metres north of Wilby Crescent and a point 6 metres further north	9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sat.	\$1.00 for 1 hour	3 hours
