BY-LAW 934-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Driftwood Avenue, Lake Shore Boulevard West, The Queensway and Weston Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule XLIV (Electric Vehicle Charging Station Parking) in § 950-1343, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Driftwood Avenue	East	A point 30.3 metres north of Niska Road and a point 12 metres further north	Anytime	3 hours
Lake Shore Boulevard West	West	A point 28.8 metres north of Superior Avenue and 6 metres further north	Anytime	3 hours
The Queensway	South	A point 24.8 metres west of Inverleigh Drive and a point 12 metres further west	Anytime	3 hours
Weston Road	West	A point 177.3 metres north of Wilby Crescent and a point 6 metres further north	Anytime	3 hours
Weston Road	West	A point 31.2 metres south of King Street Crescent and a point 6 metres further south	Anytime	3 hours
