BY-LAW 947-2023

**To permanently close a portion of public highway known municipally as Passmore Avenue
between Rouge River and Pickering Town Line.**

Whereas it is recommended that the public highway known municipally as Passmore Avenue
between Rouge River and Pickering Town Line be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the
notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto
Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who
wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on November 5, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway known municipally as Passmore Avenue between Rouge River and
Pickering Town Line and legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a
public highway:

Road Allowance between Concessions 4 & 5, Scarborough; Part of Lot 7, Concession 5
Scarborough as in SC339531 (Parcel 3); Part of Lot 8, Concession 5, Scarborough as in
SC339531 (Parcel 3); Part of Lot 12, Concession 5, Scarborough as in SC430479
(Schedule D); Part of Lot 12, Concession 4, Scarborough, as in SC430479 (Schedule B);
being Passmore Avenue between Tapscott Road & Pickering Town Line, save and except
Part 1, 66R29105, Part 1, 66R29106, Parts 1 and 2, 66R30580, and Part 2, 66R29129;
