BY-LAW 948-2023

To permanently close a portion of the public highway known as Pickering Town Line between Rouge River and Finch Avenue East.

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known municipally Pickering Town
Line between Rouge River and Finch Avenue East be permanently closed as a public highway;
and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted
on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto
Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who
wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held November 5, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Pickering Town Line between Rouge River and
Finch Avenue East and legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a
public highway:

FIRSTY: PART OF PIN 06054-0918 (LT)

Westerly Half of Road Allowance Between Township of Pickering & Township of
Scarborough being the Townline Lying Between Twyn Rivers Drive & Finch Avenue
East, save and except Part 1, 66R29274 and Part 1, 66R 29476; City of Toronto

SECONDLY: PART OF PIN 06209-0283 (LT)

Road Allowance between Townships of Scarborough and Pickering lying between River
Drive & Part 1, 66R14373; save and except Part 2, 66R29476; City of Toronto
