BY-LAW 950-2023

To permanently close the untraveled public highway between Twyn Rivers Drive and Pickering Town Line.

Whereas it is recommended that the public highway known municipally as the untraveled public road between Twyn Rivers Drive and Pickering Town Line be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on November 5, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway known as the untraveled public road between Twyn Rivers Drive and Pickering Town Line and legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Road Allowance between Concessions 2 & 3, Scarborough lying between Twyn Rivers Drive and Road Allowance between Townships of Scarborough and Pickering; City of Toronto
