BY-LAW 951-2023

To permanently close a portion of the untraveled public highway extending north of Sheppard Avenue East and east of Water Tower Gate.

Whereas it is recommended that the public highway known municipally as the untraveled public road extending north of Sheppard Avenue East and east of Water Tower Gate be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on November 5, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway known as the untraveled public road extending north of Sheppard Avenue East and east of Water Tower Gate and legally described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:
