BY-LAW 952-2023

To permanently close a portion of the public highway known as the untraveled portion of Finch Avenue East between Meadowvale Road and Beare Road.

Whereas it is recommended that the public highway known as the untraveled portion of Finch Avenue East between Meadowvale Road and Beare Road be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's website in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on November 5, 2019;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway known as the untraveled portion of Finch Avenue East between Meadowvale Road and Beare Road and described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

PART OF PIN 06054-0875

Road Allowance between Concessions 3 & 4, Scarborough, Part of Lot 4, Concession 4, Scarborough as in SC395690, being Old Finch Avenue (Formerly Finch Avenue East) lying between Beare Road & Meadowvale Road, being Finch Avenue East; save and except Parts 2, 3 & 4, 66R30400, being Finch Avenue East lying between Meadowvale Road & Beare Road; City of Toronto
