BY-LAW 975-2023

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Elvaston Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXIII (Community Safety Zones) in § 950-1332 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Location)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Hours and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Prohibited Months)
Elvaston Drive	Both	Sloane Avenue and a point 125 metres west of Halkin Crescent	Anytime	Jan. to Dec., inclusive

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXIII (Community Safety Zones) in § 950-1332 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Location)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Hours and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Prohibited Months)
Elvaston Drive	Both	Between Sloane Avenue and a point 125 metres west of Halkin Crescent (west leg)	Anytime	Jan. to Dec., inclusive
