BY-LAW 1034-2023

To authorize the alteration of Woodville Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Broadview Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Woodville Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Broadview Avenue, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Woodville Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Broadview Avenue, by the installation of five speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing Nos. TC-113 and TC-114, dated December 2022, attached to this By-law, is authorized.

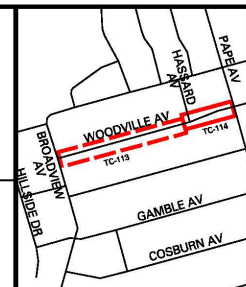


PROPOSED TWO-WAY SPEED HUMP
