### **BY-LAW 1040-2023**

**To authorize the alteration of Langley Avenue, between Carlaw Avenue and Pape Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Langley Avenue, between Carlaw Avenue and Pape Avenue, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Langley Avenue, between Carlaw Avenue and Pape Avenue, by the installation of three speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-4225, dated September 2022, attached to this By-law, is authorized.
