BY-LAW 1048-2023

To authorize the alteration of Butternut Street, between Jackman Avenue and Ellerbeck Street, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Butternut Street, between Jackman Avenue and Ellerbeck Street, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Butternut Street, between Jackman Avenue and Ellerbeck Street, by the installation of three speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing No. TC-123, dated March 2022, attached to this By-law, is authorized.

PROPOSED TWO-WAY SPEED HUMP

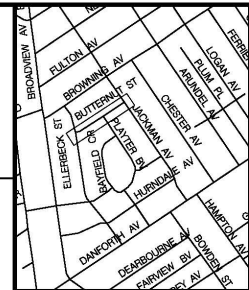
