BY-LAW 1052-2023

To authorize the alteration of Jackman Avenue, between Browning Avenue and Humdale Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Jackman Avenue, between Browning Avenue and Humdale Avenue, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

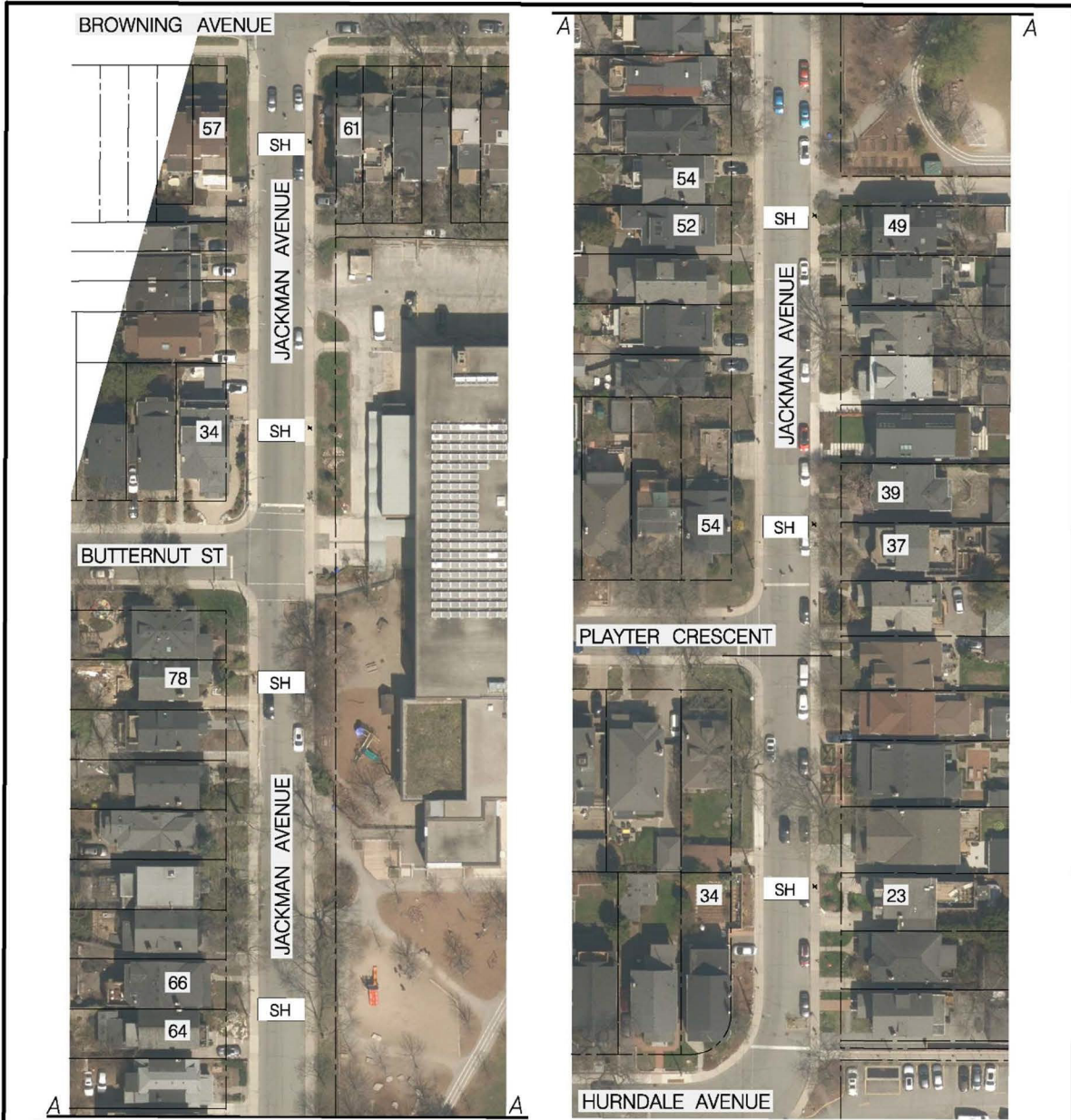
