BY-LAW 1068-2023

To authorize the alteration of Silverthorn Avenue, between Rogers Road and Rowntree Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Silverthorn Avenue, between Rogers Road and Rowntree Avenue, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

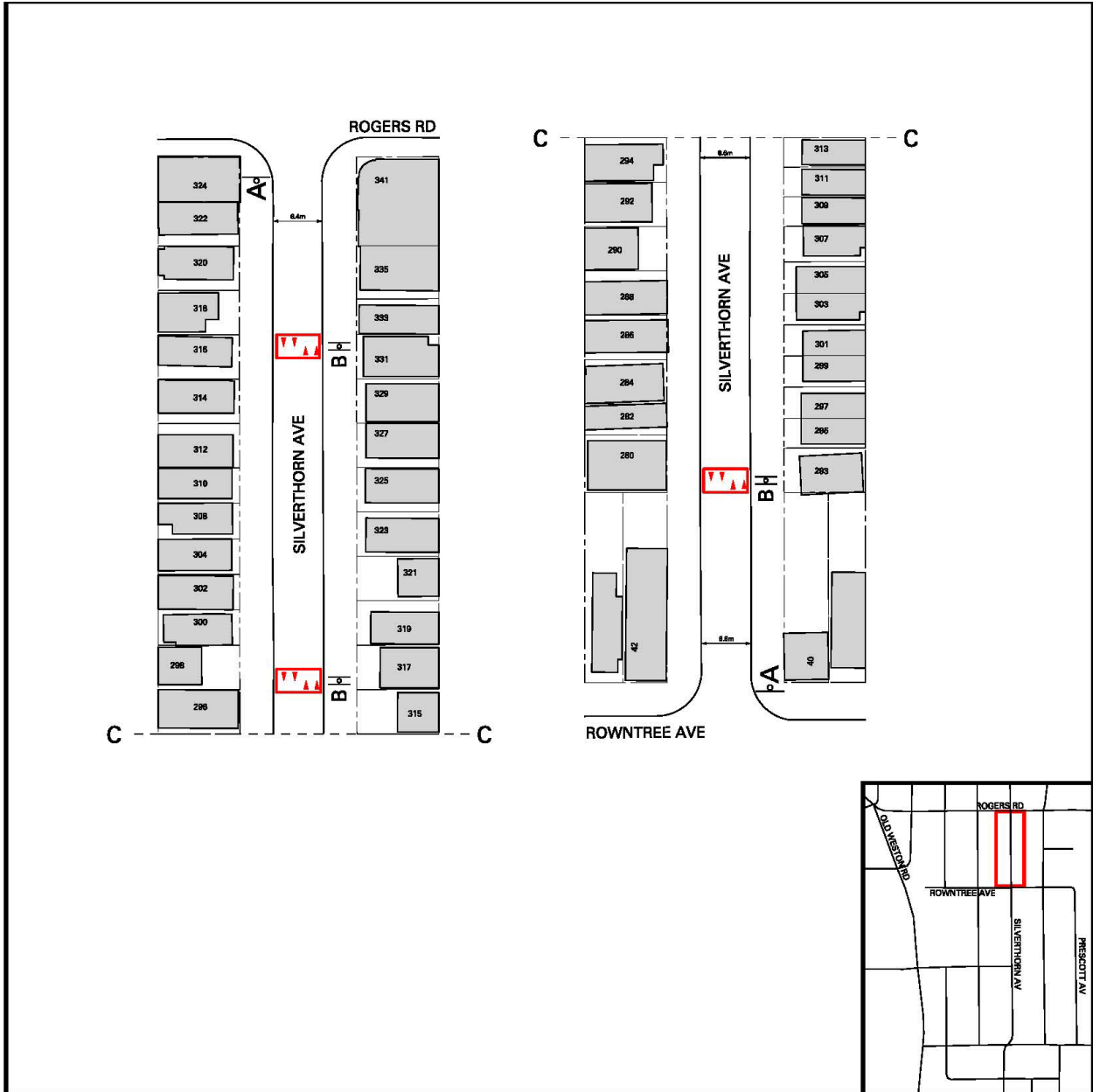
