BY-LAW 1072-2023

To authorize the alteration of Hazelton Avenue, between Davenport Road and Yorkville Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Hazelton Avenue, between Davenport Road and Yorkville Avenue, and waived polling requirements under the City's Traffic Calming Policy;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

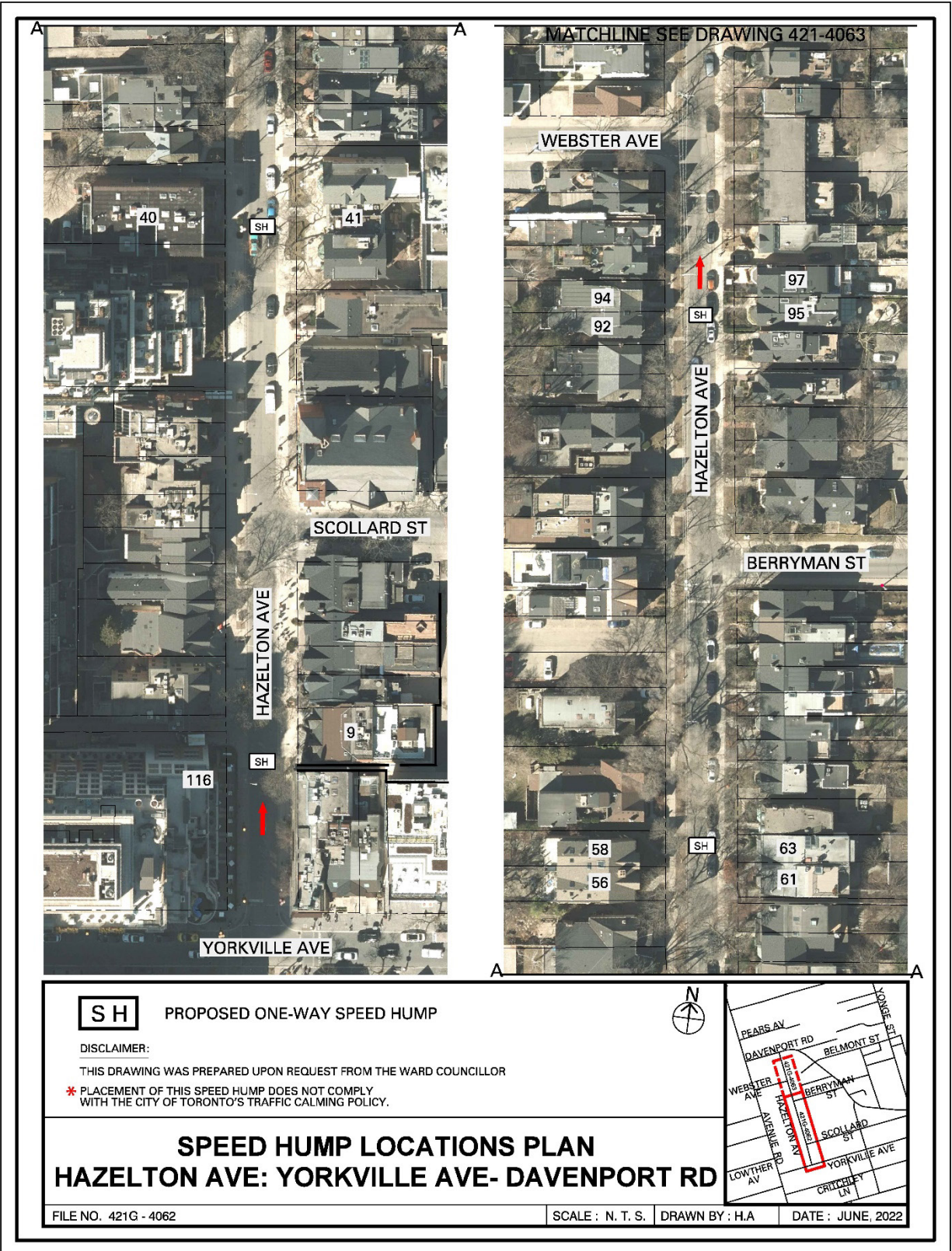
